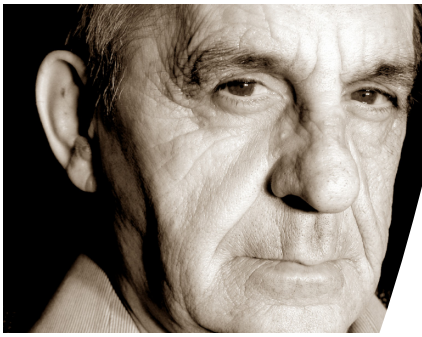
Musical Guest: David Bracken

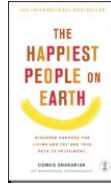
loss of thousands of dollars.

It reminded me of our very first tent meeting, out on Goodrich Boulevard, when the evangelism succeeded and my fertiliser business failed. "Lord, if You tell me that these people in Fresno are more important than a feed mill, You know I can't argue. Only - I sure wish You'd told me before I ordered all this grain."

I was sitting in the kitchen of the house on G Street. It was a beautiful late October morning, all the others were out doing errands. And there in the quiet house with only the hum of the refrigerator for company, I seemed to hear a voice, weary and a little amused:

I did tell you, Demos.

I shifted uncomfortably on the bare wooden chair. Was that true? Had God from the beginning, through my father, been warning me about this situation?



For that matter, the mill itself...had I ever clearly heard from God that this was part of His plan for the Shakarian family? Or had it been my bright idea only? Part logic, part greed - a little empire-building, perhaps, by a man whom God had already supplied with plenty? Now, when for the first time I consciously deliberately asked Him about the milling operation, the answer came loud and clear: *It's not for you, Demos.*
